of her career. The track came from Laura's debut LP, *Branigan* released in '82. Although "Gloria" took several weeks to become a hit, once it did, the song remained on the charts for several months. Another track from the LP, "All Night With Me" was a minor hit before "Gloria" hit big. Laura received a Grammy nomination for Best Pop Vocal Performance Female ("Gloria").

Laura was a former backing vocalist with Leonard Cohen in the late '70s and toured with him throughout Europe. By 1977, Laura had determination to become a solo artist, and two years later was signed with Atlantic Records. A change in managers resulted in a breach-ofcontract lawsuit, but it didn't deter Laura from becoming one of the biggest female pop artists of the decade. Laura released *Branigan2* and had two more Top 10 hits with "Solitaire" (in May) and "How Am I Supposed To Live Without You?" (hitting the Top 40 in August). Laura could also be heard on the Flashdance soundtrack with "Imagination." Laura released *Self Control* and got as high as # 2 with "Self Control." Laura also had hits with "The Lucky One" and "Ti Amo." Hold Me was released with the Top 40 hit "Spanish Eddie" and hits "I Found Someone" and "Hold Me." In 1994, Laura could be heard dueting with actor David Hasselhoff on the Baywatch soundtrack with "I Believe." Laura's acting credits have included guest shots on television's CHiPs and the films Mugsy's Girl (1984) and *Backstage* (1988). Laura also appeared on German television in An American Girl In Berlin (1981). Laura returned to the public eye in 2002, earning rave reviews with her portrayal of Janis Joplin in the hit New York City musical Love, Janis. I spoke with Joan Di Tursi a few weeks ago on the phone, and she told me that Laura is really busy in the studio recording. "It's going to be great!" said Thalía, whose accented English — she began studying it four years ago - fails to dampen her bubbly enthusiasm. "Before, I wasn't too confident in my English. Now I feel like so happy. I feel perfect." Inspired by her actress sister Laura Zapata, these days she shares homes in Miami Beach and Manhattan with Mottola, 55, whose five-year marriage to Mariah Carey ended in divorce in 1998. But Thalía's idyllic life turned nightmarish last year when Zapata and another sister were kidnapped and held for ransom in Mexico City. They were later freed unharmed, and three suspects believed connected to the kidnapping were arrested in April. "I'm very thankful," Thalía said of the ordeal's bloodless resolution. "Millions of people prayed for us." Now, as she prepares a world tour to promote her new album, Thalía says it's time to pay back fans for all the success she's enjoyed. "So many people have opened their hearts for me, now I want to make them dance, be happy and have a good time."


