November 22, 2007 -- THERE'S a Laura Branigan renaissance under way. The New York singer – who had smash hits with "Gloria" and "Self Control," then died three years ago of a brain aneurysm at 47 – was recently feted at a memorial gathering on Long Island called "Spirit of Love." And she's about to have three of her out-of-print records reissued in January after fans campaigned for their return. "She was a beautiful spirit and will never be forgotten," her drummer, **Tommy Bayiokos**, told us.
